

Mark B. Leahey is the Executive Director for the Medical Device Manufacturers Association (MDMA), a national trade association that represents manufacturers of medical devices, diagnostic products and health care information systems. His responsibilities include advocating on behalf of the entrepreneurial sector of the medical device industry to Congress, the Food and Drug Administration (FDA), the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS), and other federal agencies.

Mr. Leahey has lobbied for a more reasonable user fee for small companies, worked to open access to the hospital marketplace by challenging the exclusionary and anti-competitive nature of large group purchasing organizations (GPOs), as well as ensure that medical device technologies are reimbursed at adequate rates. Mr. Leahey currently sits on the Editorial Advisory Board of Medical Product Outsourcing and on the Medical Devices Committee for the Food and Drug Law Institute. He is a member of the Massachusetts Bar and a graduate of Georgetown University and the Georgetown Law Center.
